



Welcome to Child Watch!

Child Watch is a drop-in childcare service provided to all Copper Sky participants.

A parent or guardian (aged 16 or older) can drop off a child, **aged 18 months through 8 years old**, for **up to two hours** per day.

The parent or guardian that signs the child in *must* remain **inside the facility the entire time the child is in Child Watch.**

The Child Watch service is included with a membership, however, if your *child* does not have a Copper Sky membership you can still utilize Child Watch for an **hourly fee:**

Upon check-in, at the Child Watch counter, all children and their parent/guardian will receive a matching numbered wristband. It is imperative that the wristbands remain on until Child Watch staff removes them upon departure. **The parent/guardian wearing the wristband must be present at pick up time.**

There is a maximum capacity within Child Watch and if the room becomes full, a wait list will be started. Once on the wait list, you can remain in the lobby until your name is called over the facility intercom.

Child Watch provides a variety of toys to play with, and we model a semi-structured free play environment. Occasionally, an art project or craft will be available, and there are group activities within the room that children can participate in if they choose to.

The Child Watch staff want your children to have fun in a safe environment!

We appreciate your cooperation with abiding by the following guidelines:

- If your child is sick, please do not bring them into Child Watch. (We ask that children be fever-free for 24 hours, no vomiting or diarrhea, or contagious rashes before returning to Child Watch.)
- There are no food or snacks in Child Watch, however drinks are allowed.
- Children must be fully clothed and wearing shoes at all times.
- Child Watch staff does not change diapers. (Should your child need a diaper change, Child Watch staff will notify you. After you have changed your child, they can return to Child Watch.)
- We do not recommend toys from home. (Child Watch staff will not be responsible for lost or damaged belongings.)
- In Child Watch, time outs will be used for unacceptable behavior. (If the behavior becomes repetitive, uncontrollable, or poses a safety concern, the parent/guardian will be called to correct the behavior.)

Child Watch staff will do their best to comfort, reassure, and soothe your child should they need it. If a child cannot be comforted from crying after 10 minutes, the parent/guardian will be called.
